1. Presidents Report

Thanks to Joe Pavelchak for going above and beyond the call to serve as he will extend his Parish Council membership by one year to even out the terms of office. This was at the request of the council.

2. New Business

Request received from Pat Vanderbeck for support of our partner parish in Louisiana. They are requesting Wal-Mart gift cards in \$5.00 increments be sent to be used for toys and or food for the Christmas Holidays. The council supports announcing this special appeal one week before our monthly collection and then again on the first weekend in December when we will have the collection.



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Our partner parish has also requested help in the spring with construction projects with members of our parish traveling to Louisiana. The council recommends that Pat investigate this further and see what would be needed to participate.

Request received from Diane Gregorio, Director of Religious Education, to offer items for sale to the parish, as a fund raiser for CCD. This is approved by the council.

Request received from Diane Gregorio to offer Christmas candles and other items as a convenience with sale proceeds going to the parish. This is approved by the council.

Report from Diane Gregorio on the summer CCD program. The 2006 morning summer program was well received with 100 enrolled and 25 turned away. Feedback is that this was a very positive experience for all those that participated. Diane wants to continue the morning program and add an afternoon program. This program made for 6 less class rooms being needed during the school year and was a cost saving for the parish. The council approves expanding the program and congratulations to Diane for a job well done.

4. New Church Construction Project

Last Wednesday final approval was granted by the North Hanover planning board. The project passed the diocesan building commission. Construction documents are being drafted. Proposal from John Dawkins for construction management consultant. The construction manager works for the parish (client) and would handle day to day operations. This would be more cost effective and allow for a better bidding process than using a general contractor. The Council agrees that a construction manager should be hired and John Dawkins is the prime candidate.
