### 4. New Church Construction Project

At the next building committee meeting there will be a discussion of purchasing a generator to power the sprinkler system and building in the event of a power failure. The cost would be about \$50,000.00 for this unit. The generator is not required by code and would not save any insurance costs. The council recommendation is to **not** equip the new church with a generator.

The engineering work required by the diocese, and done by the engineering firm chosen and paid for by the diocese, is coming to a close. Our church will need to contract an engineering firm to continue the additional work that will be required to build the church. The building committee will make a recommendation on what firm to use. Fr. Joe shared the plans for the new church.
