As part of the necessity of needing to raise additional funds it is critical to have a ground breaking and a sign which is now on the property to focus attention which is already in place, to the building and fundraising efforts.

We are being charged \$25,000.00 for permits by North Hanover. John Dawkins is doing value engineering on the building.
