4. New Church Construction Project

The liturgical committee met on April 3 and a list of required items was provided. Pricing on chairs was received and there is a significant price difference between the three most popular chairs. Martin Desapio is going to Philadelphia to check what furnishings may be available for our use.

Progress is being made on the Church construction. The block work is ahead of schedule but steel work is delayed. Roofing will be starting and the windows will be installed in the classroom section. Framing is also scheduled to start. A new trailer is on site which contains the duct work for the class rooms. Curbing will be installed in the next week.

John asked if he should display pictures of the new Church at services this coming weekend. The council encourages this.
